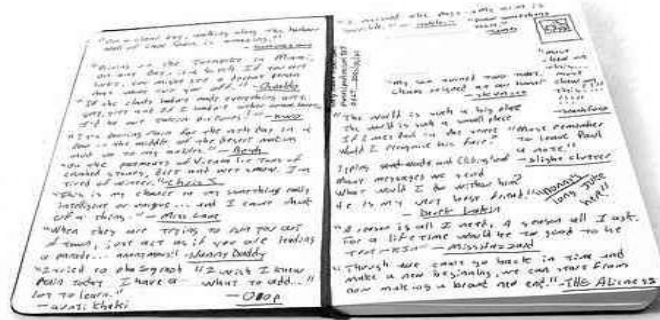


Rhetor's Notebook
